# Kansas State University

- We currently work with 75 student athletes at our daytime facility.
- 200 additional student athletes attend our night time facilities.
- All student athlete study hours and tutoring sessions are tracked with Artemis Study Hall Tracker.
- All SSIA tutors are part of ongoing training through the Total Recall program and K-State Online.

## What is Artemis Study Hall Tracker?

- The Artemis Study Hall Tracking System is built specifically for tracking and recording the attendance, progress, and time students spend in study hall.



# About Artemis

- Development team is actually one person: Nate Althoff
- Formed the original version of Study Hall Tracker while working as intern at the University of Utah
- Program is constantly evolving and changing
  - Fun fact: Artemis was the Greek god of hunting and tracking.



# Users...

- Program is 6 years old
- Kansas State University has used Study Hall Tracker for three years.
- Currently used by 19 schools in the country
  - 700 total active uses
  - Over 5,000 active students



## How it Works:

- The time a student spends in study hall is recorded when they check in, along with what that student's study plan and a record of the staff who recorded that student's attendance.
- When students check out, the total time that each student spent studying is automatically calculated and stored, along with a positive or negative rating for the session approved by the monitor.
- An area to put notes about the student's behavior during study hall, if needed, is also available.



# Tracker Tools

- User Login Manger: Allows each school to create user accounts and assign tools for each user.
- Student Admin: Create and include student athletes. Student is assigned to their sport, and this page can include number of required hours, email address, and photo for identification.
- Student Login: Tracks students signed into to system, and calculates time for reports. This tool operates in real time, so by clicking on the student name, you can see exactly how much time they have accumulated.



# Tracker Tools, Continued

- Student Reports: At KSU, this tool is used for tutoring session documentation. Tutor enters information about what was done at each session. Reports can be accessed and reviewed by coaches/advisors.
- Edit Student Hours: Self-explanatory; easy navigation to edit or create hours.
- Send Weekly Emails: Allows administrator to send emails to coaches indicating reports are ready.
- Create Semesters: Allows administrator to activate a new semester, and break down weeks.
- Archives: Reports from past semesters can be accessed.



# Facilitator Can...

- Create/manage students to be tracked in the system
- Create/manage user accounts for advisors, coaches, etc.
- Set up semesters as needed
- Generate reports as soon as the student signs out from study hall
- Send out emails as needed to notify the staff the reports are ready
  - This can all be managed by one advisor/intern to maintain privacy and organization.



# New Updates – Summer 2008

- Structure
  - Automated tasks – Student automatically signed out at 11:59 p.m.
- Tools
  - New session manager for tutor to document session details
- Reports
  - Now see daily, weekly, and monthly reports.
  - Can see reports by team or individual
- Help and Support System



## Why it is Useful:


- It eliminates the need for tracking times and names on pieces of paper or unorganized documents.
- The system generates up-to-the-minute reports on individual students or entire sports for both coaches and advisors.
- No more time wasted adding up hours and delivering hard copy reports to coaches




# Benefits

- Easy to use
- No software to purchase
- No hardware to maintain
- Program is all online, so users can access it from any site
- Updates are made during off-peak hours so system isn't disrupted
- Cost-efficient
- Customized for each school

# What is it?

- Total Recall is a study program that helps students learn almost any subject or language.
- It is used by high schools, colleges, businesses, and the government



# About Total Recall

- Total Recall develops revolutionary knowledge acquisition tools which dramatically increase retention and learning speed.
- It is a self-instruction tool rather than a testing tool. It automatically tracks your weaknesses and gives you the most practice in those areas.



# Why Total Recall Works

- Learning theory states that students forget 65% of what they are exposed to every day.
- 80% by the end of the month
- 90% by the end of the year



# Why Total Recall Works Cont.

- Total Recall provides meaningful repetitions that allows for long term retention of material.
- Athletes are used to learning in this manner, as they learn fundamentals of sport through basic daily repetitive athletic drills.



# Tools within the Program

- Modules are customized by students and/or tutors and the learning system sorts the information for individual students.
- Reporting system provides measurable results so there are no surprises at the end of the term.



# Why it beneficial for you?

- Much more cost effective way for students to build a strong foundation of learning the basics for whatever subject they are trying to learn.
- Allows for tutors to spend time engaging the students on a higher level of learning.

# K-State Online (KSOL)

K-State Online, an Internet based learning management system, transforms the everyday classroom into interactive web sessions for K-State's communities. It extends and enhances K-State course instruction, enabling students with time and geographic restrictions to take advantage of the flexibility of learning over the Internet.



# How It Works

- Every KSU student who has an EID and password has access to K-State Online.
- Page is accessed from the KSU home page.
- Upon entering KSOL, students can see all courses that they are enrolled in.
- Online instructors use KSOL as the primary tool for facilitating the online course.
- Instructors may give assignments, make announcements, send emails, post documents, hold chat or lecture sessions, and post grades to KSOL.



# How We Use KSOL

- The KSU athletic academic staff has implemented a “tutoring course” on K-State Online. Each tutor who is employed by the athletic department has been enrolled in this “course”.
- Academic staff for football and men’s basketball has also developed courses for these respective teams. Each student athlete is automatically enrolled in the course.



# Tools On K-State Online

- Announcements
- Email Instructor
  - Tutors and student athletes can email us directly from KSOL
- Files and Content
  - Upload documents
  - Outlines for procedure/tutor manual
- Assignments and Grades
  - Quizzes, homework, file dropboxes
  - Often used for student athlete or tutor surveys



# More Tools...

- Calendar
  - Tutors can see pay dates, meeting times, etc.
- Profiles
  - Users may post a profile so others can view information and get to know each other.
- Chat Rooms
  - Ability to communicate in real time if needed
- Groups
  - Tutors may be assigned to a certain site group during finals or trainings
  - Student athletes can see workout groups, academic groups, etc.
